

## Drums:

Moritz will bring **two own bassdrums**, which he needs to use for triggering purposes. **2 D.I. boxes** must be placed at the drum riser. **D.I. Box 1** is used for the trigger signal. **D.I. Box 2** conveys **samples and synths**, which are running throughout the entire show and may have to be continously mixed at the front. (intros, synths, leads, a second voice on clean sung parts) If there are problems concerning the drum-setup, please contact Moritz directly. (phone: 017632611103)

**Input List:** The Input list is to be understood as a guideline. If the location is too small to justify the listed amount of inputs, the band can adjust to most given circumstances, if informed about the location's specifics at least one week prior to the show date.

**Effects:** Reverb and Delay effects on the vocals may be dependent on the location's structure and thus are left to the discretion of the sound engineer.

A small amount of delay should be used on Nikko's clean sung parts, especially during choruses. Also, Nikko's vocals are highly dynamic and need a high compression setting in order to be heard throughout the show, with growls being notably lower in volume than sung parts.



Staying healthy on tour is important, thus the band needs to be supplied accordingly.

Bloodwork have one vegan and two vegetarians in their travel party Singer Michael is vegan, meaning catering for him must not contain any animal products whatsoever.

Robert and Nikko are vegetarian and don't consume meat. There should be **no fast food in any case**.

# **Catering should at least consist of:**

### Upon arrival:

- an assortment of breads, fillings (cheese, meat, vegetables, etc.), fresh fruit, cereals, milk...

drinks: water, coffee, soft drinks, beer, energy drinks, - at least one bottle of Jack Daniels or Jim Beam and Cola for mixing

#### Dinner:

- warm meals for all members of the travel party
- one vegan meal for singer Michael
- two vegetarian meals

Dinner needs to be warm and of decent quality. If this is not the case, the promoter will pay the band a buy-out fee of 15 € per person.

## Stage:

- at least 10 0,5l bottles of chilled still water
- at least 10 bottles of cold beer
- five clean towels
